How Long, O Lord?

- ¹ How long wilt thou forget me, O LORD? for ever? how long wilt thou hide thy face from me?
- ² How long shall I take counsel in my soul, having sorrow in my heart daily? how long shall mine enemy be exalted over me?
- ³ Consider and hear me, O LORD my God: lighten mine eyes, lest I sleep the sleep of death;
- ⁴ Lest mine enemy say, I have prevailed against him; and those that trouble me rejoice when I am moved.
- 5 But I have trusted in thy mercy; my heart shall rejoice in thy salvation.
- ⁶ I will sing unto the LORD, because he hath dealt bountifully with me.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

God — אֵלהִים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֱלֹהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

Lord — יהוָה / אֵדֹנֵי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (הְּוָהְיִ), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אָדֹנָיִי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

Mercy — רַחֲמִים (Rachamim)

Compassion, mercy

The Hebrew **rachamim** (בַּחָמִים) derives from 'womb' (rechem), suggesting tender, maternal compassion. God's mercies are 'new every morning' (Lamentations 3:23), showing His compassionate nature.

Salvation — יִשוּעַה (Yeshuah)

Salvation, deliverance

The Hebrew **yeshuah** (יְשׁוּשָהְ) means salvation or deliverance—rescue from danger or enemies. This is the root of 'Jesus' (Yeshua), meaning 'YHWH saves.'
