Chapter 135 of 150 · 21 Verses · Authorized King James Version

Praise the Name of the Lord

- ¹ Praise ye the LORD. Praise ye the name of the LORD; praise him, O ye servants of the LORD.
- ² Ye that stand in the house of the LORD, in the courts of the house of our God.
- ³ Praise the LORD; for the LORD is good: sing praises unto his name; for it is pleasant.
- ⁴ For the LORD hath chosen Jacob unto himself, and Israel for his peculiar treasure.
- ⁵ For I know that the LORD is great, and that our Lord is above all gods.
- ⁶ Whatsoever the LORD pleased, that did he in heaven, and in earth, in the seas, and all deep places.
- ⁷ He causeth the vapours to ascend from the ends of the earth; he maketh lightnings for the rain; he bringeth the wind out of his treasuries.
- ⁸ Who smote the firstborn of Egypt, both of man and beast.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

Elect — בַּחַר (Bachar)

To choose, select, elect

The Hebrew **bachar** (בַּחַר) means to choose or select—God's sovereign election. 'The LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself' (Deuteronomy 7:6).

God — אֱלהִים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֱלֹהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

Heaven — שַׁמֵּים (Shamayim)

Heaven, sky

The Hebrew **shamayim** (שְׁמֵּיִם) means heaven or sky—God's dwelling place and the realm above earth. 'The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's' (Psalm 115:16), yet 'the heaven of heavens cannot contain Him' (1 Kings 8:27).

Kingdom — מַלכות (Malkhut)

Kingdom, reign, royal power

The Hebrew **malkhut** (מַלְכוּת) denotes kingdom or royal rule—the realm and reign of a king. God's kingdom represents His sovereign rule over all creation.

Lord — יָהוַה / אֵדֹנֵי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (הְּוָהְיִ), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֲדֹנֵי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

Repent — שוב / נַחַם (Shuv / Nacham)

To turn back, relent

The Hebrew **shuv** (שוב) means to turn or return—a physical turning that represents spiritual redirection back to God. **Nacham** (מַחַם) conveys grief or relenting, often used of God 'repenting' of judgment.
