Chapter 141 of 150 · 10 Verses · Authorized King James Version

Set a Guard Over My Mouth

- 1** LORD, I cry unto thee: make haste unto me; give ear unto my voice, when I cry unto thee.
- 2** Let my prayer be set forth before thee as incense; and the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice.
- 3** Set a watch, O LORD, before my mouth; keep the door of my lips.

- 4** Incline not my heart to any evil thing, to practise wicked works with men that work iniquity: and let me not eat of their dainties.
- 5** Let the righteous smite me; it shall be a kindness: and let him reprove me; it shall be an excellent oil, which shall not break my head: for yet my prayer also shall be in their calamities.
- 6** When their judges are overthrown in stony places, they shall hear my words; for they are sweet.
- 7** Our bones are scattered at the grave's mouth, as when one cutteth and cleaveth wood upon the earth.

- 8** But mine eyes are unto thee, O GOD the Lord: in thee is my trust; leave not my soul destitute.
- 9** Keep me from the snares which they have laid for me, and the gins of the workers of iniquity.

10 Let the wicked fall into their own nets, whilst that I withal escape.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

Lord — אֱלֹהִים / יְהֹוָה (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (יהוה), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֱלֹהִים), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

Righteous — צַדִּיק (Tzaddik)

Righteous one

The Hebrew **tzaddik** (צדיק) describes one who is righteous, just, or lawful—conforming to God's standard. From the root **tzedek** (צדקה), meaning righteousness or justice.

Word — דְּבָר (Davar)

Word, thing, matter

The Hebrew **davar** (דבר) means word, thing, or matter—God's creative and authoritative speech. 'By the word of the LORD were the heavens made' (Psalm 33:6).
