

# Psalm 146:6

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

Which made heaven, and earth, the sea, and all that therein is: which keepeth truth for ever:

## Analysis

---

**Which made heaven, and earth, the sea, and all that therein is: which keepeth truth for ever.** God's trustworthiness rooted in His role as Creator—oseh shamayim va'arets (עָשָׂה שָׁמָיִם וְאָرֶץ) "maker of heaven and earth"—the covenant formula affirming Yahweh created all reality (Genesis 1:1, Exodus 20:11). Unlike powerless princes (v. 3), the Creator controls all creation's resources and powers.

**Which keepeth truth for ever** (hashshomer emet le'olam, הַשּׁׁמֵר אֶמֶת לְעוֹלָם) "truth/faithfulness/reliability" describes God's unchanging character. Shomer (שָׁמֵר) "keeps/guards" indicates active preservation of covenant promises. While human promises die with the promiser (v. 4), God's truth endures eternally, providing the only reliable foundation for trust.

## Historical Context

---

The creation formula distinguished Yahweh from pagan gods supposedly born from or limited by creation. Yahweh created all, therefore controls all. The emphasis on keeping truth forever answered Israel's experience of broken treaties, failed alliances, and unfulfilled human promises. God alone proves eternally faithful.

2. What broken human promises tempt you to doubt God's faithfulness to keep His word?

## Additional Cross-References

---

**Revelation 14:7** (Creation): Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

**Psalms 100:5** (Truth): For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.

**Psalms 95:5** (Creation): The sea is his, and he made it: and his hands formed the dry land.

**Hebrews 6:18** (Parallel theme): That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

**Psalms 117:2** (Truth): For his merciful kindness is great toward us: and the truth of the LORD endureth for ever. Praise ye the LORD.
