Chapter 16 of 150 · 11 Verses · Authorized King James Version

Preserve Me, O God

- 1** Preserve me, O God: for in thee do I put my trust.
- 2** O my soul, thou hast said unto the LORD, Thou art my Lord: my goodness extendeth not to thee;
- 3** But to the saints that are in the earth, and to the excellent, in whom is all my delight.
- 4** Their sorrows shall be multiplied that hasten after another god: their drink offerings of blood will I not offer, nor take up their names into my lips.

- 5** The LORD is the portion of mine inheritance and of my cup: thou maintainest my lot.
- 6** The lines are fallen unto me in pleasant places; yea, I have a goodly heritage.
- 7** I will bless the LORD, who hath given me counsel: my reins also instruct me in the night seasons.

- 8** I have set the LORD always before me: because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved.
- 9** Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: my flesh also shall rest in hope.
- 10** For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption.

11 Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of joy; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

Blood — דָם (Dam)

Blood

The Hebrew **dam** (דָם) means blood—representing life itself. 'The life of the flesh is in the blood' (Leviticus 17:11), and blood was required for atonement, foreshadowing Christ's sacrifice.

Forgive — נָשָׁא / סָלַח (Salach / Nasa)

To forgive, pardon, lift up

The Hebrew **salach** (סָלַח) is used exclusively of God's forgiveness—divine pardon that only He can grant. **Nasa** (נָשָׁא) means to lift up or carry away, picturing sin being removed.

Glory — כָּבוֹד (Kavod)

Glory, weight, honor

The Hebrew **kavod** (כָּבוֹד) literally means 'weight' or 'heaviness,' metaphorically denoting glory, honor, or majesty. God's glory (Shekinah) filled the tabernacle (Exodus 40:34) and temple (1 Kings 8:11).

God — אֱלֹהִים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֱלֹהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

Lord — אֲדֹנָי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (יְהֹוָה), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֲדֹנָי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.
