Chapter 21 of $150 \cdot 13$ Verses \cdot Authorized King James Version

The King Rejoices in Your Strength

- ¹ The king shall joy in thy strength, O LORD; and in thy salvation how greatly shall he rejoice!
- ² Thou hast given him his heart's desire, and hast not withholden the request of his lips. Selah.
- ³ For thou preventest him with the blessings of goodness: thou settest a crown of pure gold on his head.
- ⁴ He asked life of thee, and thou gavest it him, even length of days for ever and ever.
- ⁵ His glory is great in thy salvation: honour and majesty hast thou laid upon him.
- ⁶ For thou hast made him most blessed for ever: thou hast made him exceeding glad with thy countenance.
- ⁷ For the king trusteth in the LORD, and through the mercy of the most High he shall not be moved.
- ⁸ Thine hand shall find out all thine enemies: thy right hand shall find out those that hate thee.
- ⁹ Thou shalt make them as a fiery oven in the time of thine anger: the LORD shall swallow them up in his wrath, and the fire shall devour them.
- Their fruit shalt thou destroy from the earth, and their seed from among the children of men.

- ¹¹ For they intended evil against thee: they imagined a mischievous device, which they are not able to perform.
- 12 Therefore shalt thou make them turn their back, when thou shalt make ready thine arrows upon thy strings against the face of them.
- ¹³ Be thou exalted, LORD, in thine own strength: so will we sing and praise thy power.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

Glory — בַּבוֹד (Kavod)

Glory, weight, honor

The Hebrew **kavod** (קבוֹם) literally means 'weight' or 'heaviness,' metaphorically denoting glory, honor, or majesty. God's glory (Shekinah) filled the tabernacle (Exodus 40:34) and temple (1 Kings 8:11).

Lord — יָהוַה / אֵדֹנֵי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (יְהוָה'), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֲדֹנֵי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

Mercy — רַחֲמִים (Rachamim)

Compassion, mercy

The Hebrew **rachamim** (בְּחָמִים) derives from 'womb' (rechem), suggesting tender, maternal compassion. God's mercies are 'new every morning' (Lamentations 3:23), showing His compassionate nature.

Salvation — יִשוּעַה (Yeshuah)

Salvation, deliverance

The Hebrew **yeshuah** (יְשׁוּעָה) means salvation or deliverance—rescue from danger or enemies. This is the root of 'Jesus' (Yeshua), meaning 'YHWH saves.'

Wrath — אַף (Aph)

Wrath, anger

The Hebrew ${\bf aph}$ (9x) literally means 'nose' or 'nostrils,' idiomatically expressing wrath or anger —God's righteous indignation against sin. Yet God is 'slow to anger' (Exodus 34:6) and 'abundant in mercy.'
