Chapter 47 of 150 · 9 Verses · Authorized King James Version

God Is King over All the Earth

- 1** O clap your hands, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph.
- 2** For the LORD most high is terrible; he is a great King over all the earth.
- 3** He shall subdue the people under us, and the nations under our feet.
- 4** He shall choose our inheritance for us, the excellency of Jacob whom he loved.
Selah.

- 5** God is gone up with a shout, the LORD with the sound of a trumpet.
- 6** Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises.
- 7** For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding.
- 8** God reigneth over the heathen: God sitteth upon the throne of his holiness.
- 9** The princes of the people are gathered together, even the people of the God of Abraham: for the shields of the earth belong unto God: he is greatly exalted.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

God — אֱלֹהִים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֱלֹהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

Lord — אֲדֹנָי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (יְהֹוָה), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֲדֹנָי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

Love — אֶחֱבָה / חֶסֶד (Ahavah / Chesed)

Love / Loyal-love

Hebrew uses **ahavah** (אֶחֱבָה) for love generally, but the covenant term **chesed** (חֶסֶד) describes God's steadfast, loyal love—faithful covenant commitment beyond mere emotion.
