Chapter 49 of 150 · 20 Verses · Authorized King James Version

---

## **The Folly of Trusting in Riches**

- 1** Hear this, all ye people; give ear, all ye inhabitants of the world:
- 2** Both low and high, rich and poor, together.
- 3** My mouth shall speak of wisdom; and the meditation of my heart shall be of understanding.
- 4** I will incline mine ear to a parable: I will open my dark saying upon the harp.
- 
- 5** Wherefore should I fear in the days of evil, when the iniquity of my heels shall compass me about?
- 6** They that trust in their wealth, and boast themselves in the multitude of their riches;
- 7** None of them can by any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him:
- 8** (For the redemption of their soul is precious, and it ceaseth for ever:)
- 9** That he should still live for ever, and not see corruption.
- 10** For he seeth that wise men die, likewise the fool and the brutish person perish, and leave their wealth to others.
- 11** Their inward thought is, that their houses shall continue for ever, and their dwelling places to all generations; they call their lands after their own names.

- 12 Nevertheless man being in honour abideth not: he is like the beasts that perish.
- 13 This their way is their folly: yet their posterity approve their sayings. Selah.
- 14 Like sheep they are laid in the grave; death shall feed on them; and the upright shall have dominion over them in the morning; and their beauty shall consume in the grave from their dwelling.
- 15 But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave: for he shall receive me. Selah.
- 
- 16 Be not thou afraid when one is made rich, when the glory of his house is increased;
- 17 For when he dieth he shall carry nothing away: his glory shall not descend after him.
- 18 Though while he lived he blessed his soul: and men will praise thee, when thou doest well to thyself.
- 19 He shall go to the generation of his fathers; they shall never see light.
- 20 Man that is in honour, and understandeth not, is like the beasts that perish.

## HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

---

### Glory — כָּבוֹד (Kavod)

Glory, weight, honor

The Hebrew **kavod** (כָּבוֹד) literally means 'weight' or 'heaviness,' metaphorically denoting glory, honor, or majesty. God's glory (Shekinah) filled the tabernacle (Exodus 40:34) and temple (1 Kings 8:11).

---

### God — אֱלֹהִים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֱלֹהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

---

**Iniquity** — אָוֹן (Avon)

Iniquity, guilt, punishment

The Hebrew **avon** (אָוֹן) encompasses iniquity, guilt, and its punishment—the twisted nature of sin. 'The LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all' (Isaiah 53:6), Christ bearing our guilt and penalty.

**Redeem** — גָּאֹל (Gaal)

To redeem, act as kinsman-redeemer

The Hebrew **gaal** (גָּאֹל) means to redeem or act as kinsman-redeemer (go'el)—buying back family property or relatives. It foreshadows Christ redeeming His people through His blood.
