This their way is their folly: yet their posterity approve their sayings. Selah.

Analysis

The way of fools: 'This their way is their folly: yet their posterity approve their sayings.' Those who trust wealth follow a foolish path, yet their children repeat the same errors. Generational folly perpetuates itself as children 'approve' (literally, 'find pleasure in') their parents' misguided values.

Historical Context

Wisdom literature frequently noted how foolishness passes from generation to generation when children fail to learn from parents' errors. The cycle continues until someone breaks free through wisdom.

1. How does foolishness get transmitted from generation to generation?
2. What breaks the cycle of approving the folly of the previous generation?
