

# Psalm 50:15

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

And call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver thee, and thou shalt glorify me.

## Analysis

---

The prayer invitation: 'And call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver thee, and thou shalt glorify me.' God offers relationship: call on Him in trouble, receive deliverance, respond with glory. This is not transaction but covenant--mutual commitment, with God initiating and sustaining.

## Historical Context

---

This verse summarizes the pattern of faith: human need, divine call, prayer, deliverance, glory to God. It appears throughout biblical narrative from patriarchs through prophets to the church.

**Acts 16:25** (Parallel theme): And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.

**Matthew 5:16** (Parallel theme): Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
