Chapter 70 of 150 · 5 Verses · Authorized King James Version

Make Haste to Help Me

- 1** Make haste, O God, to deliver me; make haste to help me, O LORD.
- 2** Let them be ashamed and confounded that seek after my soul: let them be turned backward, and put to confusion, that desire my hurt.
- 3** Let them be turned back for a reward of their shame that say, Aha, aha.

- 4** Let all those that seek thee rejoice and be glad in thee: and let such as love thy salvation say continually, Let God be magnified.
- 5** But I am poor and needy: make haste unto me, O God: thou art my help and my deliverer; O LORD, make no tarrying.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

God — אֱלֹהִים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֱלֹהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

Lord — אֲדֹנֵי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (יְהֹוָה), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֲדֹנָי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

Love — אהַבָּה / אהַבָּה (Ahavah / Chesed)

Love / Loyal-love

Hebrew uses **ahavah** (אהַבָּה) for love generally, but the covenant term **chesed** (חסֵד) describes God's steadfast, loyal love—faithful covenant commitment beyond mere emotion.

Salvation — יְשֻׁעָה (Yeshuah)

Salvation, deliverance

The Hebrew **yeshuah** (יְשֻׁעָה) means salvation or deliverance—rescue from danger or enemies. This is the root of 'Jesus' (Yeshua), meaning 'YHWH saves.'
