

Psalm 73:24

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

Thou shalt guide me with thy counsel, and afterward receive me to glory.

Analysis

God 'will guide me with thy counsel, and afterward receive me to glory.' Divine guidance through Scripture and Spirit directs life's journey. 'Afterward receive me to glory' promises ultimate glorification. This links sanctification (present guidance) with glorification (future reception). The journey has a destination: being received into God's glorious presence. This hope sustains through present trials. Paul echoes this: God who began the work will complete it (Philippians 1:6), culminating in believers' glorification (Romans 8:30).

Historical Context

Israel's wilderness journey provided the paradigm: God guided by pillar of cloud and fire toward the promised land. Similarly, God guides believers through life toward eternal glory.

Study Questions

1. How does God's 'counsel' (Scripture, Spirit, providence) currently guide your life journey?
2. What does it mean to be 'received to glory'—how does this differ from merely going to heaven?
3. How does confidence in ultimate glorification sustain you through present guidance and trials?

Additional Cross-References

Psalms 32:8 (Parallel theme): I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye.

Isaiah 58:11 (Parallel theme): And the LORD shall guide thee continually, and satisfy thy soul in drought, and make fat thy bones: and thou shalt be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters fail not.

Isaiah 48:17 (Parallel theme): Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.

James 1:5 (Parallel theme): If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

Isaiah 58:8 (Glory): Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy rereward.

Psalms 84:11 (Glory): For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.

Psalms 16:7 (Parallel theme): I will bless the LORD, who hath given me counsel: my reins also instruct me in the night seasons.
