

# Psalms 78:15

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

He clave the rocks in the wilderness, and gave them drink as out of the great depths.

## Analysis

---

**He clave the rocks in the wilderness, and gave them drink as out of the great depths**—the rock-striking at Rephidim (Exodus 17:6) and Kadesh (Numbers 20:11) demonstrated YHWH's power to transform barren stone into life-giving water. The verb *bāqa'* (clave) parallels the sea-splitting (v. 13), showing God divides impossibilities to sustain His people.

Paul explicitly identifies this rock as Christ: 'they drank from the spiritual rock that followed them, and the rock was Christ' (1 Corinthians 10:4). The smitten rock typifies Christ's crucifixion—struck once to pour out living water (John 7:37-39). Moses's error at Kadesh (striking twice instead of speaking) violated this typology, barring him from Canaan (Numbers 20:12).

## Historical Context

---

Rephidim (Exodus 17) occurred early in the wilderness wanderings, while Kadesh (Numbers 20) happened in the fortieth year. Both incidents tested whether Israel would trust God's provision or quarrel against His leadership.

## Additional Cross-References

---

**Psalms 105:41** (Parallel theme): He opened the rock, and the waters gushed out; they ran in the dry places like a river.

**Exodus 17:6** (Parallel theme): Behold, I will stand before thee there upon the rock in Horeb; and thou shalt smite the rock, and there shall come water out of it, that the people may drink. And Moses did so in the sight of the elders of Israel.

**Numbers 20:11** (Parallel theme): And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also.

**1 Corinthians 10:4** (Parallel theme): And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.

**Psalms 114:8** (Parallel theme): Which turned the rock into a standing water, the flint into a fountain of waters.

**Revelation 22:1** (Parallel theme): And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.

**Revelation 22:17** (Parallel theme): And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

**Isaiah 43:20** (Parallel theme): The beast of the field shall honour me, the dragons and the owls: because I give waters in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert, to give drink to my people, my chosen.

**Isaiah 48:21** (Parallel theme): And they thirsted not when he led them through the deserts: he caused the waters to flow out of the rock for them: he clave the rock also, and the waters gushed out.

**Isaiah 41:18** (Parallel theme): I will open rivers in high places, and fountains in the midst of the valleys: I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and the dry land springs of water.
