

# Psalms 80

Chapter 80 of 150 · 19 Verses · Authorized King James Version

---

## Restore Us, O God

- 1** Give ear, O Shepherd of Israel, thou that leadest Joseph like a flock; thou that dwellest between the cherubims, shine forth.
- 2** Before Ephraim and Benjamin and Manasseh stir up thy strength, and come and save us.
- 3** Turn us again, O God, and cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved.

---

- 4** O LORD God of hosts, how long wilt thou be angry against the prayer of thy people?
- 5** Thou feedest them with the bread of tears; and givest them tears to drink in great measure.
- 6** Thou makest us a strife unto our neighbours: and our enemies laugh among themselves.
- 7** Turn us again, O God of hosts, and cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved.

---

- 8** Thou hast brought a vine out of Egypt: thou hast cast out the heathen, and planted it.
- 9** Thou preparedst room before it, and didst cause it to take deep root, and it filled the land.
- 10** The hills were covered with the shadow of it, and the boughs thereof were like the goodly cedars.

**11** She sent out her boughs unto the sea, and her branches unto the river.

**12** Why hast thou then broken down her hedges, so that all they which pass by the way do pluck her?

**13** The boar out of the wood doth waste it, and the wild beast of the field doth devour it.

**14** Return, we beseech thee, O God of hosts: look down from heaven, and behold, and visit this vine;

**15** And the vineyard which thy right hand hath planted, and the branch that thou madest strong for thyself.

**16** It is burned with fire, it is cut down: they perish at the rebuke of thy countenance.

**17** Let thy hand be upon the man of thy right hand, upon the son of man whom thou madest strong for thyself.

**18** So will not we go back from thee: quicken us, and we will call upon thy name.

**19** Turn us again, O LORD God of hosts, cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved.

## HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

### God — אלֹהִים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֱלֹהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

### Heaven — שָׁמָיִם (Shamayim)

Heaven, sky

The Hebrew **shamayim** (שָׁמָיִם) means heaven or sky—God's dwelling place and the realm above earth. 'The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's' (Psalm 115:16), yet 'the heaven of heavens cannot contain Him' (1 Kings 8:27).

**Lord** — אֱלֹהִים / יְהֹוָה (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (יְהֹוָה), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֱלֹהִים), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

**Save** — יָשַׁא (Yasha)

To save, deliver, rescue

The Hebrew **yasha** (יָשַׁא) means to save or deliver—rescue from danger or distress. This is the root of 'Jesus' (Yeshua), meaning 'YHWH saves.' God alone is Savior: 'I, even I, am the LORD; and beside me there is no saviour' (Isaiah 43:11).

**Salvation** — יְשֻׁעָה (Yeshuah)

Salvation, deliverance

The Hebrew **yeshuah** (יְשֻׁעָה) means salvation or deliverance—rescue from danger or enemies. This is the root of 'Jesus' (Yeshua), meaning 'YHWH saves.'
