

# Psalms 86

Chapter 86 of 150 · 17 Verses · Authorized King James Version

---

## Great Is Your Steadfast Love

- <sup>1</sup> Bow down thine ear, O LORD, hear me: for I am poor and needy.
- <sup>2</sup> Preserve my soul; for I am holy: O thou my God, save thy servant that trusteth in thee.
- <sup>3</sup> Be merciful unto me, O Lord: for I cry unto thee daily.
- <sup>4</sup> Rejoice the soul of thy servant: for unto thee, O Lord, do I lift up my soul.
- <sup>5</sup> For thou, Lord, art good, and ready to forgive; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon thee.

- <sup>6</sup> Give ear, O LORD, unto my prayer; and attend to the voice of my supplications.
- <sup>7</sup> In the day of my trouble I will call upon thee: for thou wilt answer me.
- <sup>8</sup> Among the gods there is none like unto thee, O Lord; neither are there any works like unto thy works.
- <sup>9</sup> All nations whom thou hast made shall come and worship before thee, O Lord; and shall glorify thy name.
- <sup>10</sup> For thou art great, and doest wondrous things: thou art God alone.

- <sup>11</sup> Teach me thy way, O LORD; I will walk in thy truth: unite my heart to fear thy name.

## HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

---

### **God** — אֱלֹהִים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֱלֹהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

---

### **Lord** — אֲדֹנָי / יְהוָה (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (יְהוָה), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֲדֹנָי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

---

### **Love** — אַהֲבָה / חֶסֶד (Ahavah / Chesed)

Love / Loyal-love

Hebrew uses **ahavah** (אַהֲבָה) for love generally, but the covenant term **chesed** (חֶסֶד) describes God's steadfast, loyal love—faithful covenant commitment beyond mere emotion.

---

### **Mercy** — רַחֲמִים (Rachamim)

Compassion, mercy

The Hebrew **rachamim** (רַחֲמִים) derives from 'womb' (rechem), suggesting tender, maternal compassion. God's mercies are 'new every morning' (Lamentations 3:23), showing His compassionate nature.

---

**Salvation** — יְשׁוּעָה (Yeshuah)

Salvation, deliverance

The Hebrew **yeshuah** (יְשׁוּעָה) means salvation or deliverance—rescue from danger or enemies.

This is the root of 'Jesus' (Yeshua), meaning 'YHWH saves.'

---

**Truth** — אֱמֶת (Emet)

Truth, faithfulness

The Hebrew **emet** (אֱמֶת) means truth or faithfulness—reliability and conformity to reality. God is true (emet), utterly faithful to His word and character.

---

**Save** — יָשַׁע (Yasha)

To save, deliver, rescue

The Hebrew **yasha** (יָשַׁע) means to save or deliver—rescue from danger or distress. This is the root of 'Jesus' (Yeshua), meaning 'YHWH saves.' God alone is Savior: 'I, even I, am the LORD; and beside me there is no saviour' (Isaiah 43:11).
