Chapter 88 of 150 · 18 Verses · Authorized King James Version

I Cry Out Day and Night

- ¹ O LORD God of my salvation, I have cried day and night before thee:
- ² Let my prayer come before thee: incline thine ear unto my cry;
- ³ For my soul is full of troubles: and my life draweth nigh unto the grave.
- ⁴ I am counted with them that go down into the pit: I am as a man that hath no strength:
- ⁵ Free among the dead, like the slain that lie in the grave, whom thou rememberest no more: and they are cut off from thy hand.
- ⁶ Thou hast laid me in the lowest pit, in darkness, in the deeps.
- ⁷ Thy wrath lieth hard upon me, and thou hast afflicted me with all thy waves. Selah.
- ⁸ Thou hast put away mine acquaintance far from me; thou hast made me an abomination unto them: I am shut up, and I cannot come forth.
- ⁹ Mine eye mourneth by reason of affliction: LORD, I have called daily upon thee, I have stretched out my hands unto thee.
- ¹⁰ Wilt thou shew wonders to the dead? shall the dead arise and praise thee? Selah.
- Shall thy lovingkindness be declared in the grave? or thy faithfulness in destruction?

- Shall thy wonders be known in the dark? and thy righteousness in the land of forgetfulness?
- ¹³ But unto thee have I cried, O LORD; and in the morning shall my prayer prevent thee.
- ¹⁴ LORD, why castest thou off my soul? why hidest thou thy face from me?
- I am afflicted and ready to die from my youth up: while I suffer thy terrors I am distracted.
- ¹⁶ Thy fierce wrath goeth over me; thy terrors have cut me off.
- ¹⁷ They came round about me daily like water; they compassed me about together.
- 18 Lover and friend hast thou put far from me, and mine acquaintance into darkness.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

Faith — אֵמוּנַה (Emunah)

Faithfulness, trust

The Hebrew **emunah** (אֲמוּנָה) encompasses both faith and faithfulness—trusting God and being trustworthy. It implies steadfast reliability, as in 'The just shall live by his faith' (Habakkuk 2:4).

Lord — יָהוָה / אֵדֹנֵי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (יְהוָּה), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֲדֹנֵי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

Love — אַהַבָּה / חֵסֶד (Ahavah / Chesed)

Love / Loyal-love

Hebrew uses **ahavah** (אַהֶּבָה) for love generally, but the covenant term **chesed** (תְּסֶּד) describes God's steadfast, loyal love—faithful covenant commitment beyond mere emotion.

Righteous — צַדִּיק (Tzaddik)

Righteous one

The Hebrew **tzaddik** (צַּדִיק) describes one who is righteous, just, or lawful—conforming to God's standard. From the root tzedek (צָּדֶק), meaning righteousness or justice.

Salvation — יְשׁוּעָה (Yeshuah)

Salvation, deliverance

The Hebrew **yeshuah** (יְשׁוּשָׁהְ) means salvation or deliverance—rescue from danger or enemies. This is the root of 'Jesus' (Yeshua), meaning 'YHWH saves.'

Wrath — אַף (Aph)

Wrath, anger

The Hebrew **aph** (אַף) literally means 'nose' or 'nostrils,' idiomatically expressing wrath or anger —God's righteous indignation against sin. Yet God is 'slow to anger' (Exodus 34:6) and 'abundant in mercy.'
