## **Solomon Praises the Shulamite's Beauty**

- <sup>1</sup> How beautiful are thy feet with shoes, O prince's daughter! the joints of thy thighs are like jewels, the work of the hands of a cunning workman.
- <sup>2</sup> Thy navel is like a round goblet, which wanteth not liquor: thy belly is like an heap of wheat set about with lilies.
- <sup>3</sup> Thy two breasts are like two young roes that are twins.
- <sup>4</sup> Thy neck is as a tower of ivory; thine eyes like the fishpools in Heshbon, by the gate of Bath-rabbim: thy nose is as the tower of Lebanon which looketh toward Damascus.
- <sup>5</sup> Thine head upon thee is like Carmel, and the hair of thine head like purple; the king is held in the galleries.
- <sup>6</sup> How fair and how pleasant art thou, O love, for delights!
- $^{7}$  This thy stature is like to a palm tree, and thy breasts to clusters of grapes.
- <sup>8</sup> I said, I will go up to the palm tree, I will take hold of the boughs thereof: now also thy breasts shall be as clusters of the vine, and the smell of thy nose like apples;
- <sup>9</sup> And the roof of thy mouth like the best wine for my beloved, that goeth down sweetly, causing the lips of those that are asleep to speak.

<sup>10</sup> I am my beloved's, and his desire is toward me.

- <sup>11</sup> Come, my beloved, let us go forth into the field; let us lodge in the villages.
- <sup>12</sup> Let us get up early to the vineyards; let us see if the vine flourish, whether the tender grape appear, and the pomegranates bud forth: there will I give thee my loves.
- 13 The mandrakes give a smell, and at our gates are all manner of pleasant fruits, new and old, which I have laid up for thee, O my beloved.

Love — אַהֲבָה / חֶסֶד (Ahavah / Chesed)

Love / Loyal-love

Hebrew uses **ahavah** (אַהֶּבָּה) for love generally, but the covenant term **chesed** (תְּסָד) describes God's steadfast, loyal love—faithful covenant commitment beyond mere emotion.
