JESUS TOLD HIS disciples to meet Him on a mountain in Galilee. When they saw Him, they fell down and worshiped Him!

Jesus had something VERY important to tell them.

'ALL power in heaven and earth has been given to Me,' Jesus said.

The disciples listened carefully.

'So HERE'S what I want you to do: GO! Go to ALL the nations—every country in the whole world!'

Jesus continued: 'Make disciples everywhere. Baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Teach them to obey everything I've taught you.'
