

# Simon Peter

The Twelve · The Twelve Apostles

A fisherman from Bethsaida, Simon received the name Peter (Greek Πέτρος, Petros, 'rock') from Christ. His leadership among the apostles, his great confession, his threefold denial, and his restoration mark him as emblematic of both human weakness and divine grace.

**Note:** Peter's prominence appears in the apostolic listings (always named first), his spokespersonship for the Twelve, his role at Pentecost, and his ministry to the circumcision. Tradition holds he was martyred in Rome, crucified upside down at his own request.

## Key Verses

### **Matthew 16:16**

And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.

### **Matthew 16:18**

And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.
